About the Club

Established in January 1978, the Wagga Wagga Four Wheel Drive Club is one of the longest running 4WD Clubs in Australia. It is a family-oriented club of around 100 families (vehicles) with members from all walks of life and all age groups from Wagga Wagga and surrounding districts. The Club motto, "*Living the Adventure!*" encapsulates what we do.

The Club promotes responsible four wheel driving and care for the environment with comprehensive Club Rules, affiliation with Four Wheel Drive NSW & ACT (the Association of Four Wheel Drive Clubs www.4wdnow.com), and support for Tread Lightly and the Code of Ethics of Four Wheel Drive Australia.



Club Activities

- **Trips:** Regular day and weekend trips to areas of interest in southern NSW and northern Vic, and longer expeditions: the deserts, Cape York, K'Gari Is (Fraser Is). Trips are graded on level of difficulty and are led by experienced Club members.
- **Social events:** Bush dinners, BBQ's, Christmas parties, fishing trips etc.
- **Skills development:** Driver training; technical workshops; map reading & navigation exercises; fun days; first aid training; chain saw training; trip leader training; photography etc.
- **Monthly meetings:** Discussions on Club business. Frequently, guest speakers talk on topics of interest to members. Visitors are welcome.
- **Public events:** Monthly "Come and Try Mornings" at the Club's Quarry Training Area; information sessions and displays at community events.
- **Community Service:** Active support of the community includes assisting National Parks & Wildlife Service with fire trail clearing and mountain hut re-building, supporting charities (including Royal Flying Doctor Service), and providing access to the Club's Quarry Training Area for organisations like Australian Defence Force, Police, Rural Fire Service, paramedics and schools etc to use for driver training and education programs.
- **Newsletter:** "TrackChat" newsletter is published monthly and is available on the Club's web site.
