



COURSE OVERVIEW - RAFA 3 Day Course

Learners who undertake this course will be exposed to a number of realistic lifelike emergency scenarios which aid in the delivery of course material. Learners exposed to these scenarios will gain valuable knowledge and experience in responding to a number of emergencies.

During this course learners will take part in and learn how to respond to a range of scenarios and incidents such as;

- multiple vehicle accidents – multiple injuries
- winch breakage – internal and external bleeding
- fire pit incident – multiple limbs burnt
- fall from heights – off the top of a parked vehicle
- allergic reaction – reaction to a bee sting
- envenomation – snake bite
- jack failure – crush injury & internal bleeding
- diabetic with head injury - rock fall
- near drowning - small boat capsized
- fractured leg - collapsed trailer jack
- identifying a person who is sick and needs to be evacuated
- identification of strokes and heart attack
- calling for help in remote locations (sat phone, PLBs, Trackers, UHF, ground signaling)
- setting up for arriving medical assistance
- moving the injured
- Identifying, monitoring and managing shock
- chemical related emergency

QUALIFICATION – Learners will gain the following Statement of Attainments upon successful completion of the course;

- HLTAID005 - Provide first aid in remote situations
- HLTAID003 - Provide First Aid
- HLTAID001 - Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

COURSE ASSESSMENT – This course is 90% practical; learners will be assessed via the pre-course learning and via the practical scenarios throughout the duration of the course. The following assessment tasks are required for this course:

- 8 written questions
- 50 Multiple choice questions
- Simulated emergency scenario's

COURSE FEE – **\$480.00 Per/Pers.** Group discounts apply for clubs or organisations hosting the RSS training Team. This course requires a minimum of 8 students to start with a maximum of 22 per course. Travel and accommodation to remote locations is not included in the above figure

COURSE DURATION – 3 Days with 1 night session. Normal course hours are 830am - 430pm
